

Sol Wassermuhl, Principal, Page + Steele Architects

Upon graduating from McGill in 1969, Sol Wassermuhl was hired as a designer by Page & Steele, one of Toronto's major award-winning architectural firms, established in 1926. Sol became a principal partner in 1983, and in 1993 the President of Page+Steele Architects. Under his direction, the firm has grown to its current size of over 100, with award-winning projects in Canada, the United States, Europe and the Middle East.

Sol is a member of the Toronto Design Review Panel and has been guest lecturer at the University of Toronto and University of Waterloo, and was recognized for his contributions to architecture by being honoured as a Fellow of the Royal Architectural Institute of Canada.

P+S has completed worldwide hotel projects, including recent Four Seasons Hotels in Prague and Amman, a resort in Shanghai, and prestige developments in Moscow, Budapest on the Danube, Las Vegas and New York.

Page+Steele has earned a well-deserved reputation as the premier designers of high-end luxury hotels and hotel-condominium projects such as the recently completed Hazelton, The Windsor Arms Hotel and Residences, Soho Metropolitan Hotel and Residences, The Oriental Mandarin Hotel and Residences in Las Vegas and, of course, the Ritz Carlton Hotel and Residences in construction here in Toronto.
